Application deadline: 28th February 2017

Why is Shell closing applications on 28th February 2017?

We want to make some improvements to the graduate recruitment process for the future, to do this we need to close the system down. The changes to the recruitment process will be communicated in April 2017.

What will the new assessment process look like after 1st April 2017?

The new process is still in development. Once it launches we will provide new and updated resources and advice on our website.

When will applications reopen?

Applications reopen on 1st April 2017.

Which graduate programmes will be effected by this closing date?

Applications will close on 28th February 2017 for all Graduate roles and all Assessed Internships. They will then all reopen on 1st April 2017.

Is there an advantage to applying now or waiting until April?

The changes we are making will update the process but will not change what we look for in a potential candidate. There is no advantage to waiting. If you are hoping to start a role or internship in 2017, you will need to apply and complete the needed online assessments on or before 28th Feb to meet the intake timeline.

I am thinking about applying, what should I do?

We advise students and graduates interested in 2017 Graduate roles and Assessed Internships to apply and complete the online assessments before midnight on 28th February 2017. However, we strongly recommend that you do not wait until the last day to apply; applications are being processed in chronological order. I would like to apply for a role in another country – what should I do?

You can continue to apply using the country website for the country to which you are applying. You must have valid and legal permission to work in that country. Check the specific country website for detailed information.

I have started my application and have completed some of the elements but haven't had an offer yet, what should I do?

Your application will continue to be progressed and you do not need to do anything other than meet the timeline given to you throughout the application journey.

I'm waiting for a date for my Interview or Shell Recruitment Day, what should I do?

You do not need to do anything at this point. We will continue to schedule assessments as normal and will be contacting you as soon as we have a date.
